Ofsted Report

We are very proud to be able to share the report from our recent Ofsted inspection. As it was a section 8 inspection the school's grade could not change, so we remain a good school, but we hope you agree that this is an excellent report and a great reflection of our wonderful school and its community. School Data

While we assess children's progress and attainment continuously throughout their time at school, there are various points at which data is collected and shared beyond the school. These include the GLD (Good Level of Development) at the end of Reception, the phonics check in Year 1, the times table check in Year 4 and the Year 6 SATs. We are pleased to be able to share all of Bessemer's data for this year, with the national levels for comparison. As this year's national data is not all available yet we are using some 2023 data for comparison, however this tends not to vary by more than around 1% each year.


Meet the Teacher





Year 6 Enterprise Project

This term in maths the Year 6 pupils have been working in groups on an Enterprise project. Each group needed to prepare a pitch to request £5 to buy the ingredients to make a product of their own design. They initially designed a survey for their target market to get some insight into what their customer base would like, used their computing skills to present their findings, then using this information they designed a snack to be sold after school.

Last week, the pupils went to Sainsbury's to buy their ingredients, then made their products. During the project children have had to apply their number and calculation skills and understanding of measures, when deciding the affordability of their ingredients, and used scaling to increase the quantities in their recipes. They have had to show excellent teamwork skills in order to successfully complete the tasks and they also have had a lot of fun!




