
Autumn Term Library Visits

News and Reminders

Attendance



Our target for school attendance is 96% and the majority of children at Bessemer achieve this target. This attendance ladder will help you keep track of your child's attendance; over the course of the whole year a child with 96% attendance should only have 7 days off school. At this point in the year, to achieve 96% attendance a child can only have missed 2 days of school. We understand that some absence is unavoidable, for example if your child has a temperature, vomiting bug or infectious illness such as chicken pox, however children can come to school when they are not feeling 100% well and they often feel much better once they are in school with their friends. Over the next two weeks we will be contacting the parents of children whose attendance has dropped below 90% (which is categorized as persistent absence) to offer support and see how attendance can be improved.




Sharing Children's Learning Demonstrating our core value of being *Creative and Practical*

Here are some photos of 3/4BW beginning their stop-frame animation unit in their first session with the iPads. They used the software I-motion to take the photos of stick people and then tried to make them move by slightly changing the picture (frame) each time to create an animation.

In Art, Year 1 children were introduced to Picasso. The children explored a selection of his art works and noticed their different features. They explored how the art made them feel. The children noticed how colourful many of his pieces of art are and then explored colour themselves, firstly looking at prime colours and them using these three colours to mix new colours. Finally they painted portraits of their grandparents in the style of Picasso.




