News and Reminders

Online Safety

This week children in KS2 attended online safety workshops delivered by Childnet. We organised these workshops because issues involving the internet and social media have become the largest part of our safeguarding workload and are becoming increasingly concerning. While we teach online safety constantly in school we felt the children would also benefit from expert input from an external provider. The workshops were focused on the various ways that children need to keep themselves safe online, e.g. avoiding inappropriate content and knowing what to do if they see something inappropriate, keeping their personal details private (which extends much further than just not giving out your phone number or address to strangers online) and protecting their privacy and being kind on social media.

We also organized a parent workshop after school with the same provider. The workshop was great, with lots of practical, helpful tips and advice. It was disappointing that so few people were able to attend, but the feedback from those who were there was very positive, so we are sharing a recording of the workshop for parents and carers to watch https://vimeo.com/1005450813/9c8f63d869. 












Word of the Week

Online Safety Tip of the Week


