

This term, Year 2's geography topic is **Continents and Oceans**. They took part in lots of fun activities throughout the day, including reading maps, using compass points to follow a route, beating the clock in a geography Kahoot quiz, and even travelling around the school on a treasure hunt!









Year 6 visit the Houses of Parliament

Today, Year 6 went on their first trip of the year - and what a trip it was! In connection with both their PSHE learning and their new history topic, The Ancient Greeks, both classes went to the Houses of Parliament to learn about what democracy looks like in our country, a concept that began with the Ancient Greeks thousands of years ago. They learnt about the history of how our country was governed, from the rule of the monarchy to our present-day system. They were then taken on a tour of Parliament, finding out more about its history and how government works. They even got to stand in the House of Lords and the House of Commons, where our MPs and Prime Minister debate.



Year 6 Art Week - Frida Khalo

Year 6 have been exploring the artist Frida Kahlo, her compositions, use of colour and symbolism in her work. Finally, drawing inspiration from her work, the children experimented with ideas for their own self-portrait before creating their final piece, a self-portrait in mixed media (paint and collage) inspired by the work of Frida Kahlo.
