Topic- Our topic for this term is 'Social and Environmental Activism'. We will be learning about activists who work hard to make positive changes in the world. Please make sure your child is completing their topic homework which can be found in the green topic books.



English - This term in English, we will be developing our writing skills through looking at a variety of different texts, including a range of fiction and non-fiction. Our main text for the first

few weeks will be 'Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. In spelling, we will be continuing with the spelling rockets and we will be consolidating these spellings through handwriting (letter join). During guided reading, we will be exploring a range of fiction and non-fiction.



Maths - We will be looking at Decimals for the first few weeks of the half term to help us explore using Money. We will then move on to Geometry and Time.

Science - In science we will be consolidating our learning and working on our scientific skills. They will develop skills in knowledge, reasoning and classifying. We will be continuing with Sound and recapping the previous science topics this year.
