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History - Our topic this half term is Our Grandparents

Our Topic this term is 'Our Grandparents'. You will be receiving a knowledge organiser letter detailing what we will be doing during this topic, homework and other ideas to support your child's learning at home.

For our Grandparents topic it would be fantastic if we could have some real-life grandparents come and visit us in class and talk to the children in a Q&A session. If your child's grandparent is happy and willing to visit us then please liaise with your child's class teacher to organise a suitable time.

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English -

We will start this term with the book 'The Colour Monster' and discussing our emotions about our return to school. This book will help us label and deal with our emotions whilst we are at school. We will then move on to 'Here We Are' By Oliver Jeffers. We will be discussing our place in the world and how the world has changed and continues to evolve around us.



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Reading – One of the most effective ways you can support your child with their academic progress and development, is through reading together regularly. Your child will receive a book from school which they should look after, and bring into school each day.

Children should be reading at home each day, preferably with an adult, for at least 10 minutes.

Please sign your child's reading record each day to show they are reading regularly and so they can earn rewards in school. Please note, there is a £5 charge for lost books.



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Maths - In maths, we will begin with 'Place Value' through number recognition and representing numbers in different ways using a variety of objects. We use concrete resources to deepen our understanding and ensure we are able to use different counting strategies to find the total amount.



Why not do some baking at home, count how many seconds your child can brush their teeth for, how many jumps they can do in 30 seconds, look at door and bus numbers and other numbers in our everyday environment to further reinforce these skills?

Science - This term we are beginning our science study with weather and seasonal change. We will be investigating different weather types and how these can be recorded. We will look at the months of the year and how the seasons affect the world around us! We will then start to look at our bodies and the five senses. You will receive a separate knowledge organiser letter regarding science in the next few weeks.



R.E – This half term we will be learning about what it means to belong. We will be looking at the Hindu celebration of Divali.

P.E – This half term we are learning multi-skills and incorporating fundamental movement skills.

All children **must** wear their PE kit into school on the specified days. PE kit should consist of plain navy (black or grey if necessary) bottoms (leggings, shorts or tracksuit bottoms), a white school t-shirt or gem house t-shirt and trainers. This should be worn with a school jumper or cardigan.

PSHE - This half term, we will be concentrating on feelings and emotions in our PSHE sessions and developing the children's coping strategies when encountering change and building up their resilience.

Music - This half term, and throughout our learning journey in Year 1, we will have weekly music lessons with Duncan from Southwark Music Services. These will start in week three and each class will get a half an hour slot.





Computing - This half term, we are looking at technology around us. We will be investigating technology we see on a daily basis and technology we see in our classroom. Is a pencil technology? Is a seat technology? What other types of technology can you think of?
