History / Geography - Our topic this half term is Japan

We will be learning about Japan's physical and human features and how they have adapted their infrastructure. We will also be hosting a Japan day where the children have the opportunity to make sushi!

English - This half term, our class text will be: The Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen. Through this text, we will be writing a number of fiction and non-fiction texts including letters of advice, diary entries, newspaper reports and various narratives.



Reading – One of the most effective ways you can support your child with their academic progress and development is through reading together regularly. Your child will receive a book from school which they should look after, and bring into school each day.

Children should be reading at home each day, preferably with an adult, for 20 minutes. Please sign your child's reading record each day to show they are reading regularly and they can earn rewards in school. Please note, there is a £5 charge for lost books.



Maths - This half term we will be working on fractions, decimals and percentages. You can support your child at home by continuing to complete the weekly SATS practise homework. Remember, our maths scheme 'White Rose' has a parent area where your child can consolidate any learning in class. There are videos for each lesson taught.
