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Geography - Our topic this half term is Rivers! We will be having a focus on how we benefit from rivers. We will be learning the features of a river, enhancing our mapping skills using coordinates and learn about the effects rivers have on the landscape.

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English - This half term, we will start by reading the historical fiction story, Diver's Daughter by Patrice Lawrence, set in Tudor times. We will be writing a setting description, a diary entry and a recount and at the end of the unit we will write our own endings to the story.

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Maths - This half term, we will be finishing off addition and subtraction, before moving on to length and perimeter and beginning multiplication and division. We will be working on our mental maths skills in preparation for our weekly maths rocket test. This will take place every Friday. Homework will be set on Google Classroom on Fridays and will support the facts needed for the rocket tests. Children will be rewarded gems as appropriate as an added incentive to complete their homework.

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Science - This half term, we will be learning about States of Matter and the Water Cycle.

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Homework - This year we will be putting the homework options on Google Classroom. Each week there will be a piece of maths homework which will be linked to times tables or the rocket card steps which may be an interactive activity or questions to answer. There will also be weekly spellings and the half termly topic homework.
